- - Large-scale entertainment facilities called "theme parks" are designed based on the concept that people can enter a fantastic world using their own imagination to escape from their daily lives. Both Tokyo Disneyland and Universal Studios Japan continue to produce new events to entertain people. One of their main targets is to increase the number of their repeat customers.
  - These theme parks offer various kinds of shows, such as electric parades and spectacular fireworks. In recent years, these parks have started to use a new technology called projection mapping, which has proven to be successful in drawing a great number of people. One example of this for entertainment is the show at Tokyo Disneyland, which features computer-generated images of popular Disney characters projected on the walls of Cinderella Castle.
  - Projection mapping is a new technology that casts images on the walls of buildings with sound effects. What sets this form of entertainment apart from films is that unlike movies, which can now be viewed on any device at any time, you cannot enjoy the show unless you actually visit the place. The technology is believed to have been popularized when "Tokyo Station Vision" was held in 2012. Many people gathered at Tokyo Station to watch the spectacular visual display.

- A popular Buddhist image in Nara has been chosen as a <u>subject</u> of projection mapping. The name of the image is Ashura. Its <u>tender</u> face and merciful\* look have charmed many people over the centuries. So it is no wonder that Ashura was projected during the Sapporo Snow festival.
- The 3D masterpiece, Ashura, was transported beyond ancient times to the modern day, showing the power of the perfect expression created by cutting-edge\* technology. The clear pop-up images were screened on the back of a replica\* of Kofukuji Temple made of snow blocks. People were able to enjoy the fantastic view for a short time.
