Most people have taken antibiotics^{*} at some point in their lives. Doctors prescribe these very useful medicines to $_{(1)}$ fight bacterial infections resulting from wounds, to treat infections of organs such as the kidney, and to treat diseases such as pneumonia.

The antibiotics we commonly use today were $_{(2)}$ <u>discovered</u> quite a long time ago. Penicillin was $_{(3)}$ <u>identified</u> by Alexander Fleming in 1928. Even the newer antibiotics such as amoxicillin entered the market several decades ago.

And this indicates a major problem — almost no new classes of antibiotics have been discovered since the 1970s. Furthermore, in the meantime, bacteria have become resistant to existing antibiotics. (4) <u>Life-threatening</u> "superbugs" have appeared all over the world, resistant to almost all classes of antibiotics.

Now, researchers in the United States may have found a way forward. They investigated microbes* in the soil for their anti-bacterial properties. This has been done before, but one problem has been that very few microbes will grow in laboratory conditions. To overcome this, the team at Northeastern University in Boston used special equipment to ₍₅₎ <u>culture</u> the microbes in their native soil. In their natural environment, they grew into colonies, which could then be tested to find possible antibiotics.
