  - Young people today are always connected. Mobile technology has given us phones that have almost become part of our bodies. Today's youth are the first generation to grow up in an always-connected world. This is a huge difference from their parents' generation.
  - One unique characteristic of today's social networks is their real-time, everpresent nature. Whether it is during class, lunchtime or when doing homework,
    many young people are aware when a new message comes in. Some even sleep
    with their mobile phone beside their pillow so they can check their networks and
    respond in the middle of the night.
  - There are several reasons for this super connectivity. Teenagers are building a personal identity. Social networks with friends are suitable platforms for seeking an identity. Another reason is related to the new culture of participation. Groups of friends play games or share information such as music, photos and videos. They often mix the information together in a creative way, such as using stickers. Thus, people can share with their group members using the new technology. A third reason is related to the need to belong to a group, which is very important to many people.
  - Naturally being connected all the time also has its disadvantages. Some youths become addicted to their phones and networks. Hearing the sound or feeling the vibration of an incoming message becomes almost like a drug and they sometimes ignore their studies. Also, because most people post only good things about themselves, it is easy to become depressed seeing everyone always having a good time.
  - There are also physical health concerns associated with constantly using mobile phones. Staring down at a small screen for hours can be hard on the eyes and the neck. Moreover, if you are always sitting down using your phone, you are unlikely to get enough exercise.
  - Finally, although today's parents complain about young people using their phones too much, they may have forgotten about their own behavior when they were young. At that time, their own parents may have complained about them

watching too much TV and talking too long on the phone. Therefore, in one sense, today's connected youth are actually not so different from their parents. However, in those days, when they hung up the phone, the connection was cut.
