For example, Zealandia, a large wildlife sanctuary near the city center, offers many trails for visitors to enjoy. They can observe birds and plants native to the region while breathing in the fresh air of the forest. Second, tourists can visit locations where blockbuster movies were filmed. Mount Victoria, for instance, is one of the places where a <sup>(3)</sup>well-known fantasy movie series, *The Lord of the Rings*, was shot. In fact, Wellington is known for its movie industry, and there are many <sup>(4)</sup>facilities related to film production including special effects companies. The city even has a nickname “Wellywood,” which combines the city name with the name of the world’s movie capital. Finally, tourists can enjoy delicious food at popular restaurants. The city center is filled with restaurants featuring a variety of local and international food. Roast lamb, fish and chips, and hamburgers are some of the dishes tourists often <sup>(5)</sup>order. Visitors can also have a nice cup of coffee in one of more than 300 cafes in the city. Wellington indeed has something to offer to every tourist who visits this beautiful city.

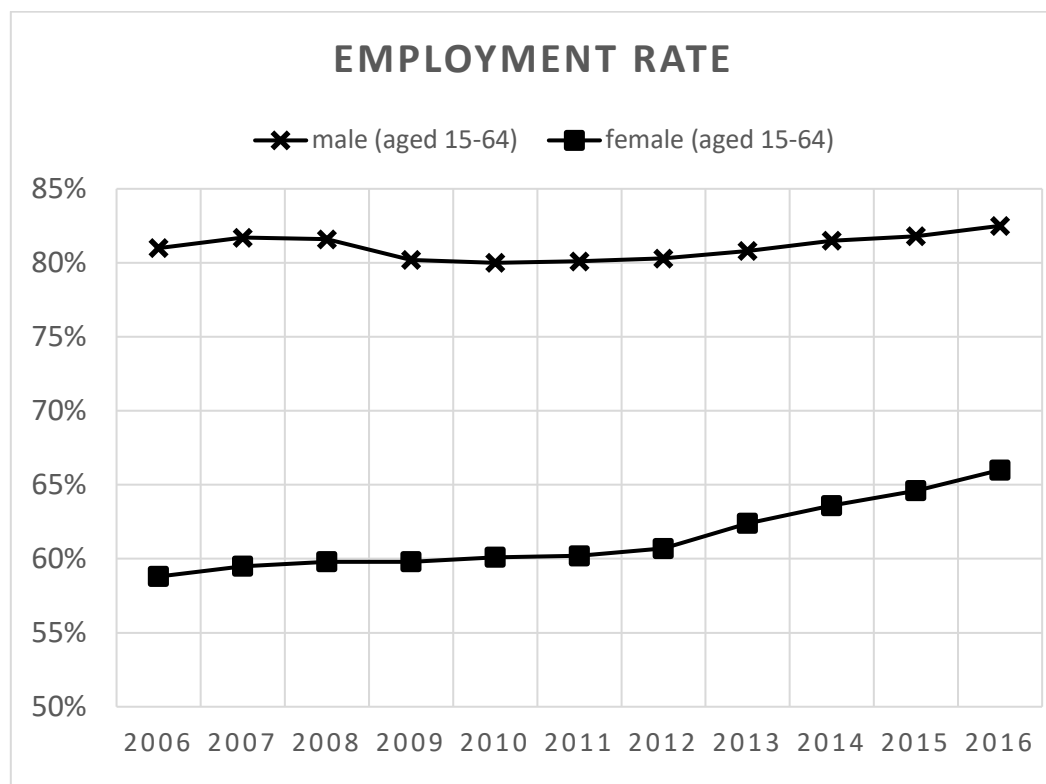
