- - Pop-up retail* is a new approach to retail that has gained popularity in recent years. Perhaps you have seen pop-up stores in shopping malls, event spaces, or else in the lobbies of large buildings.
 - A pop-up store is basically a shop that will open and do business for a limited period of time, which could be as short as one day or as long as several weeks. After the period is up, the shop disappears.
 - The retail industry uses pop-up stores for multiple purposes. One of the main objectives is to sell seasonal goods, and thus pop-up Halloween stores and Christmas stores appear at certain times of the year. Other uses for pop-up stores are to introduce new products to the market, stimulate public interest in the products, and simultaneously judge consumer reaction. And one more common purpose is to sell products that have become trendy, especially when the trend seems likely to last for just a short time. One example of pop-up retail was seen during the COVID-19 pandemic*, when pop-up stores appeared in various locations selling fashionable reusable face masks.
 - Pop-up retail can be described as a "win-win-win" business situation. First of all, producers can benefit, because they get new and flexible routes for their products to reach customers. Businesses offering retail space can also win, because space that might otherwise be unused can be leased for a profit. Retailers can win in several ways. For example, since overhead costs* are low compared to a permanent store, it is much easier for retailers to open a shop and start making a profit. They can also use pop-up retail to respond quickly to trends in society. And last but not least, consumers win by being able to buy unique products, often at discount prices. And, of course, pop-up retail makes shopping malls and shopping areas livelier and more fun for consumers.
 - Pop-up stores are particularly appealing for young people eager to follow the latest trends. Furthermore, because young people exchange so much information on social media, they can get details of the trendiest pop-up stores and pay a visit before they disappear.
