- 次の文章を読み、設問に答えなさい。なお、文章の左にある数字は段落の番号を表しています。

  - You've probably heard of Billie Eilish, but unless you're a fan, there are many interesting things about her you may not know. First, her full name is Billie Eilish Pirate Baird O'Connell. She also has caring, open-minded parents who have encouraged their kids to explore their passions. Some activities Eilish pursued as a child included horseback riding, dancing, and singing.
  - Billie Eilish found fame at a young age. Her first song, "Ocean Eyes," went viral\* in 2015. She was only 13 years old. In 2020, she became the youngest person ever to win a Grammy Award for Album of the Year. The prize was for her debut album, When We Fall Asleep, Where Do We Go?, which features the hit song "Bad Guy."
  - Teenagers who rise to sudden fame often encounter difficulties dealing with the pressure, but Billie Eilish is not like the typical female pop star who does her best to present a cheerful, positive image. Instead, Eilish doesn't hide her shortcomings, because they are perfectly normal. For example, Eilish's lyrics address her struggles with mental health and suicidal thoughts\*. She says her music is like therapy that makes these problems easier to deal with, though this is not a perfect solution. She is a very hard worker, which drains\* her physically. Meanwhile, her celebrity status drains her emotionally.
  - Billie Eilish usually puts on loose clothing, but a photo was taken of her wearing tighter clothes than usual. "Trolls" (internet bullies) "body-shamed" her (criticized her appearance) online. This incident received a lot of attention as well as a large and quick backlash\* against the trolling. Eilish said she originally started wearing loose clothes because she "hated" her body, but now she openly rejects body-shaming and the notion that a woman should have a certain feminine appearance. In fact, she goes out of her way to dress the complete opposite of the bodies." Many young Americans, both girls and boys, have been encouraged and inspired by this stance on standards of beauty.
