- - America is not a soccer powerhouse*, but the U.S. Women's National Team transformed that image by winning the FIFA Women's World Cup in 2015 and 2019. How does this success compare to the men's team? They did not even qualify* for the 2018 World Cup. They were knocked out in the round of sixteen in 2014. They have never gotten past the World Cup quarterfinals since finishing third in 1930. Yet in 2014, the men's team received performance bonuses of \$5.4 million. When the women's team beat Japan in the 2015 World Cup final, they only got \$1.7 million in bonuses, even though the match was the most-watched soccer game ever in the U.S., with 25 million viewers.
 - When in 2016, five women's players complained to the government, the U.S. Soccer Federation said they do not deserve as much pay because the attention they get is not worth as much money. In 2018, the players took stronger action when they sued* the U.S. Soccer Federation for gender discrimination. Abby Wambach, a member of the 2015 championship team and now retired, believes additional financial support from sponsors helped the U.S. women's team defend their championship in 2019. On the international level, although FIFA increased prize money for the Women's World Cup from \$15 million to \$30 million in 2015,

the men's teams at the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar will share \$440 million, up from \$400 million in 2018.

In other sports, the U.S. women's hockey team, which has won Olympic medals in all six hockey sports, won stronger support from their national organization after threatening to boycott the 2017 World Championship because of pay. The Women's National Basketball Association recently tripled the pay female players receive, though it is still far below what men in the NBA earn. Katelyn Ohashi, a college gymnastics champion, believes the media will devote more attention to female athletes. Women are also making inroads* in men's sports. In 2015, Sarah Thomas became the first woman to work as a referee for the National Football League. Alyssa Nakken became Major League Baseball's first female full-time coach when the San Francisco Giants hired her.
